Code of conduct for School Tours

This Code of Conduct will be observed whilst touring the Venues of the Albany Historical Society (Inc).

- 1 No running inside the Albany Convict Gaol, Patrick Taylor Cottage, Brig Amity or the Albany Co-Op.
2. No running in the Courtyard of the Albany Convict Gaol.
3. No running on the veranda of Patrick Taylor Cottage.
4. No running on the upper deck of the Brig Amity.
5. No locking any persons in the Cells at the Albany Convict Gaol or Cabins of the Brig Amity.
6. No yelling, screaming, swearing or fighting.
7. No handling or touching any artefacts.
8. No throwing stones at glass atop the walls at the Albany Convict Gaol.
9. No climbing the Rigging on board of the Brig Amity.
10. All bags must be left at the Attendant's office at the Albany Convict Gaol, Brig Amity, and on the veranda whilst at Patrick Taylor Cottage.
11. No Drinking or Eating whilst on any Albany Historical Society (Inc) property. Exceptions to this may apply where a School has arranged with the Society to take Morning, Afternoon tea or Lunch on site.
12. Other visitors must be treated with Courtesy and Respect.

- Any damage to property will be the responsibility of the visiting School.
- Whilst the Albany Historical Society Inc acknowledges its responsibilities under the law. Conduct is ultimately the responsibility of the Teachers and Parents accompanying the group.
